Hello Husky Families,

We hope everyone was able to work through the Zoom meetings, Google Classroom assignments, and work packets this week. We know that this “new normal” is overwhelming for everyone, but we appreciate your best effort as we live our distance learning plan. We are confident as the weeks pass, you will settle into a routine and your stress level will greatly diminish.

We are sending out a Google Forms survey next week which will gauge how you are doing with the academic workload. Please take a few minutes to fill it out so we can adjust the work and activities accordingly.

We do have some guidelines that we would like you to reiterate with your students:

- 1. Students must enter the Zoom session using their correct first and last names.**
- 2. Participants must use the video function.**
- 3. Normal classroom expectations are in place. If your student does not adhere to these expectations you will receive an email or phone call from the teacher. After your child receives a warning, if they continue to break rules they will only be allowed to access the session recordings - they will no longer be able to participate “live”.**
- 4. Unfortunately, some of our Huskies are inviting non HA friends into their frames in a Zoom session. This is an immediate cause to be removed from “live” sessions.**
