Oakland County in partnership with Honor Community Health will offer COVID-19 drive through testing by appointment only.

WHEN: Beginning April 16, 2020

TIME: 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM • Monday - Friday

WHERE: 1200 N Telegraph, County Complex, follow the drive-up testing signs to:

Large parking lot behind the Medical Examiners Facility (Building 28 E)

WHO: People with COVID-19 symptoms, 18 years or older.
Priority given to:

- Residents of Pontiac
- First Responders
- Essential or critical infrastructure employees
- Those who are 65 years and older
- Individuals with underlying conditions

Tests are limited to 50-100 in the first two days and 250 per day going forward until more testing capacity is available.
