

Holly Academy will be offering all Husky families the option of choosing a blended model this fall.

This option is **FREE** to all interested families.







## Blended model learning includes:

- Students receive in-person teaching and learning on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.\*
- Students work in Husky Virtual Academy on Tuesday and Thursday.
- Personal protective equipment is required for all staff at all times.
- All student desks will be spaced as far apart as feasible, with all students facing forward.
- Y5-5th grade students will "cohort" in their homeroom class throughout the day to limit movement within the school.
- Y5-5th grade students are required to wear masks in common areas, while entering or exiting the buildings, and in restrooms.
- Y5-5th grade students are not required to wear masks in the classroom or at recess, but are welcome to do so.
- Specials teachers will rotate to homeroom classrooms to limit student movement and co-mingling of cohort groups.
- Middle school students will be assigned a cohort and will receive a block schedule to limit transitions and co-mingling of cohort groups.
- While in school, middle school students must wear a mask at all times while inside a building. Outside mask breaks will be provided throughout the day.
- Outside space will be utilized for all students as an extra learning environment, as much as possible.
- \* While in school, students who are on the blended model will be in a cohort with students who are in the fully in-person model.

Several upgrades have been made to our facility during the summer such as hand sanitizer stations, self flushing toilets, and self dispensing paper towel holders. Our staff is dedicated to keeping high traffic areas continuously clean during the school day with safe cleaning products. Dare to be remarkable at Holly Academy!
